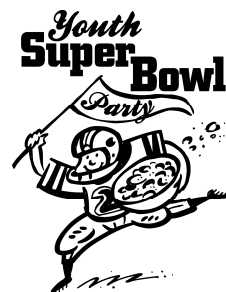
Book Signing
